We focus on preparing you to conduct yourself professionally in various situations, ensuring you are ready for success when you complete the course.

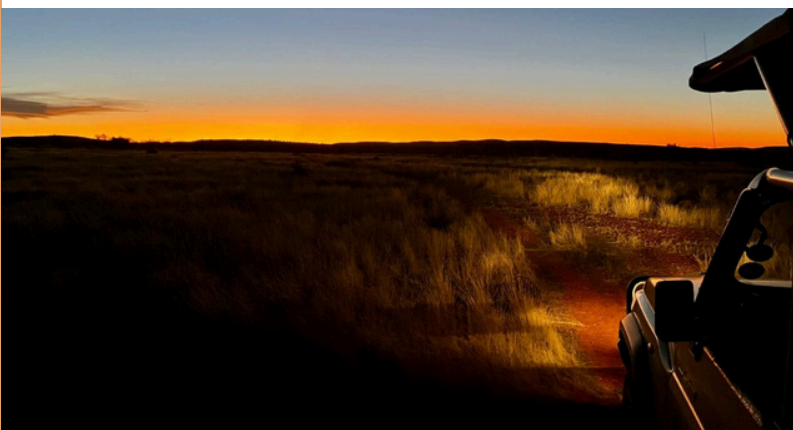


COMPONENT ONE

THE FGASA SYLLABUS INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING KEY MODULES

Guiding in the Natural Environment:

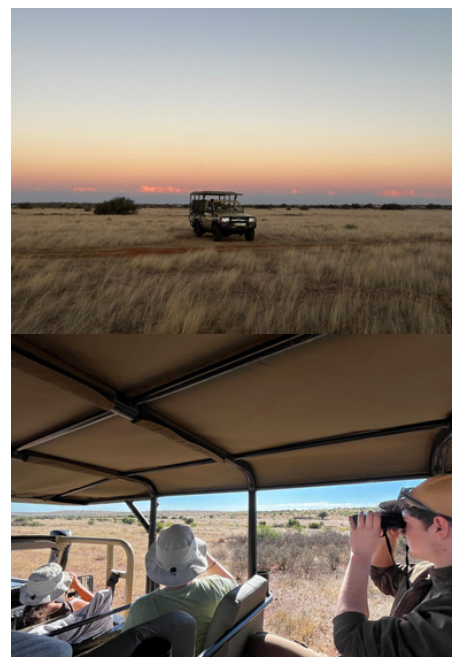

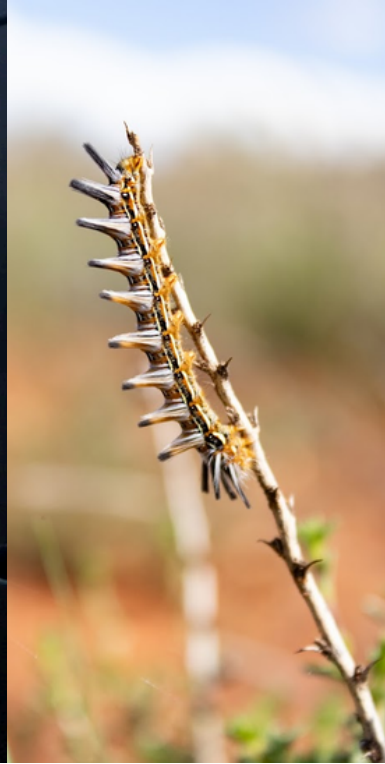

Kukama students are heading to Maloba Private Game Reserve for the final phase of their course, an immersive, real-environment training block that prepares them for life as professional guides. Maloba offers diverse habitats, free-roaming wildlife and authentic working-reserve conditions, making it the ideal place for students to apply their skills beyond the classroom.

The reserve is home to some of the Big 5, including species such as Rhino, Lion and Buffalo, as well as endangered wildlife like Cheetah, giving students the opportunity to develop awareness, safety understanding and responsible conservation practices around high-profile animals.

DURING THEIR TIME THERE, STUDENTS WILL:

- Take part in reserve-based activities.
- Conduct practical assessments in the field.
- Gain confidence in real guiding scenarios.
- Experience how a functioning private reserve operates.
- Develop awareness, safety, tracking and observation skills.

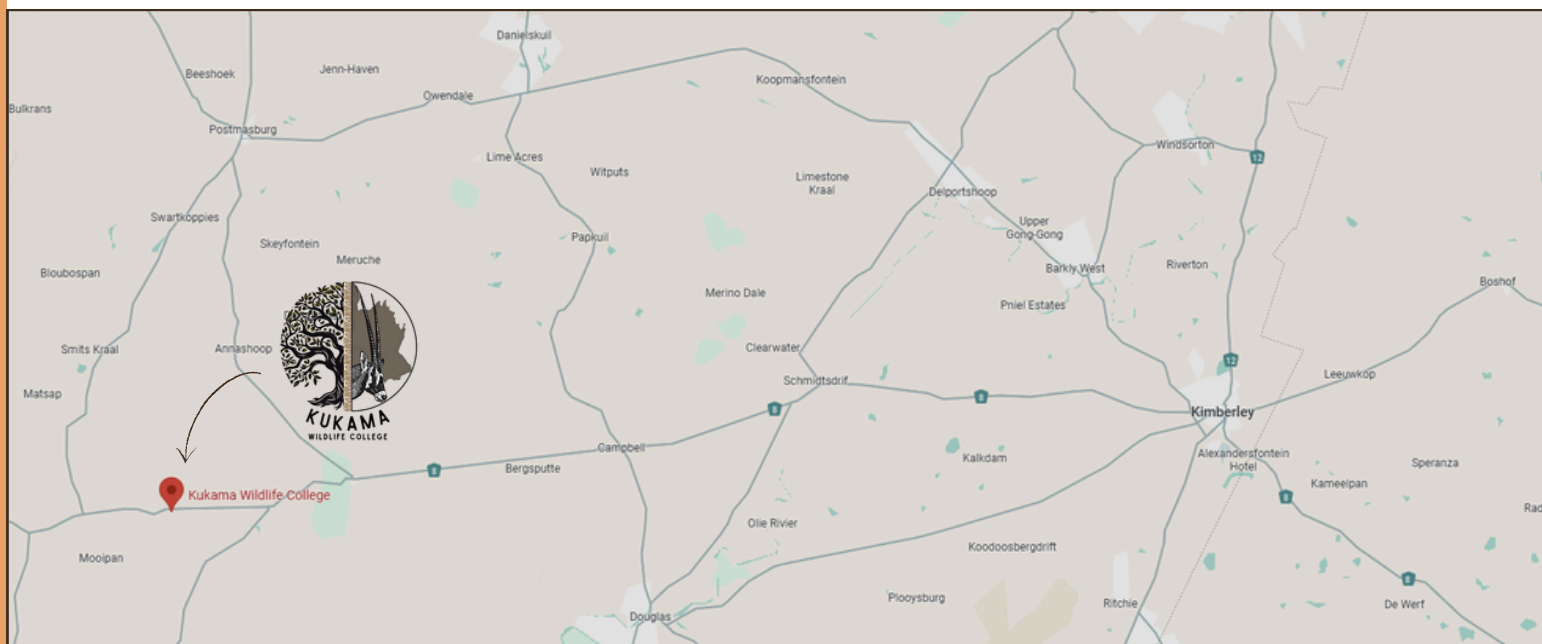

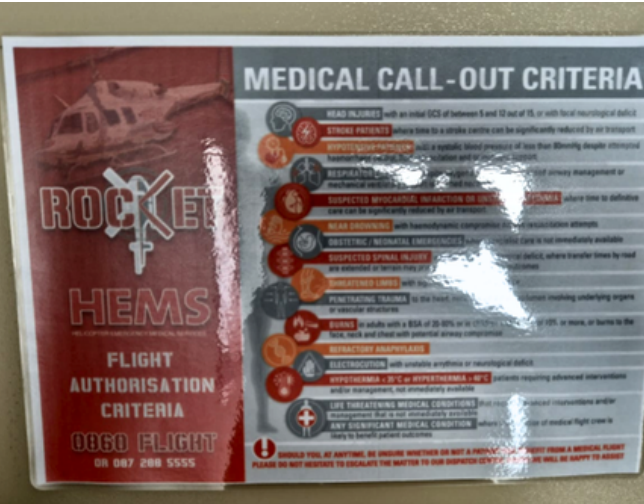
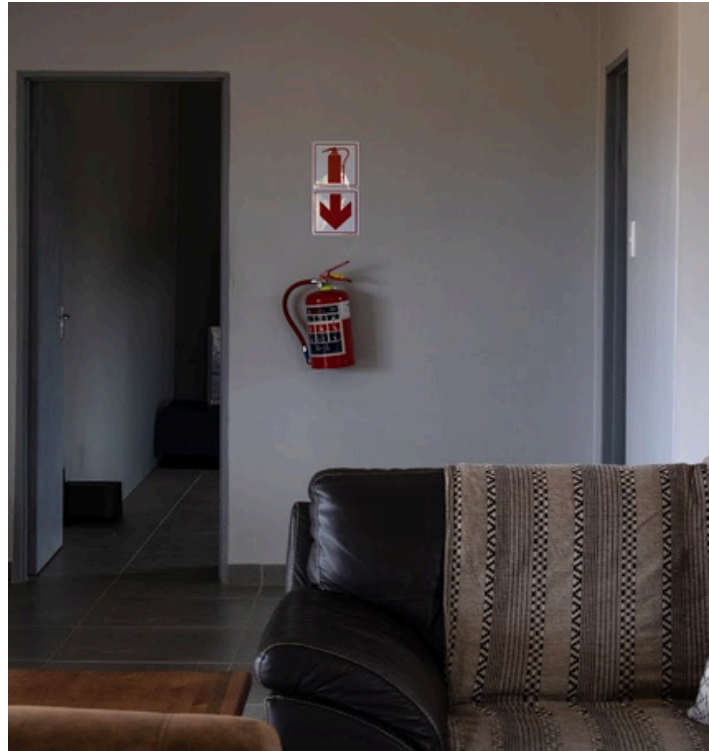


HEALTH & SAFETY
